## ICYMI: 450+ RALLY FOR GAZA IN OXFORD WITH DRS. GHASSAN ABU-SITTAH AND OMER ABDUL MANNAN

Hundreds of Oxford students, faculty, staff, and community members rallied to demand the Oxford Administration meet OA4P's demands

16 May 2024; OXFORD, UK -- On Thursday evening, the Oxford Action for Palestine (OA4P) coalition hosted a rally and press conference in city centre with Dr. Ghassan Abu-Sittah. The emergency rally was announced in direct response to Tuesday's disappointing statement from the Vice Chancellor, which – after a week of silence – was issued to the university community with a complete refusal to engage with OA4P's demands or meet to discuss them further. The Vice Chancellor's statement has provoked fury throughout the Oxford community – and today, nearly 500 students, faculty, staff, and community members rallied to channel their anger into action.

OA4P's Gaza Solidarity Encampment has garnered widespread support and nearly quadrupled in size since its founding. Endorsements for OA4P and its demands have been issued by over 500 members of University faculty and staff, Oxford University healthcare workers, and fourteen Oxford trade union affiliates, including Oxford UCU and the Oxford and District Trade Unions Council.
