Students in the process of scheduling a meeting with Vice Chancellor and other Senior Members of Administration

6 June 2024; OXFORD, UK -- On Thursday morning, students from the Oxford Action for Palestine encampment announced that Vice-Chancellor Irene Tracey and other senior members of the Oxford University Administration have responded to their email request for a meeting, expressing the desire to work with the students on matters pertaining to OA4P's demands. The students are in the process of arranging a date and time for discussion.

OA4P released the following statement on Thursday morning:

"Today marks exactly one month since OA4P established our Gaza Solidarity encampment. In that time, israel's genocidal assault on Gaza has persisted despite widespread condemnation from the international community. Just this week, israel relaunched its ground invasion in central Gaza, following days of systemic air strikes of UN shelters and residential areas.

Gaza can't wait, and neither can we. We are eager to meet with the Vice Chancellor and the Administration, and we look forward to working closely with the University to address our collective obligation to act in the face of this genocide."
